Coming from Battle Creek

From the east take exit 92 off I-94. Turn left at the end of the exit. This is Mercury Drive. Follow Mercury Drive four miles west to 44th Street. Turn left on 44th Street go one mile south into town. Go straight through town. The Jr/Sr High School is on the south end of town on your right.

Coming from Kalamazoo

From the west take exit 88 off I-94. Go straight at the end of the exit ramp on 40th Street. The Target Corporation will be on your right. Take 40th Street until it dead ends at MN Avenue. Turn left on MN Avenue. Drive east two miles and turn right on 44th Street. Drive one mile into town. Go straight through town. The Jr/Sr High School is on the south end of town on your right.
