### Meet Deena

Despite never showing any symptoms of cancer, Deena Patterson was diagnosed with stage IV lung cancer on March 26th, 2021. Initially, she went in to see the doctor about concussion-like symptoms because she hit her head on a garage door. What proceeded next was a valiant fight for her life that included brain surgery, radiation, and chemotherapy. Even though the chemo was successfully defeating the cancer, there were many complications with the drug she was taking. Sadly, Deena passed on December 3rd, 2022 after an incredibly brave struggle with her illness. This year's

Memorial Event not only remembers Deena's courageous battle for her life, but also celebrates the incredible life she lived and the many loved ones she affected along the way.
