# Dance, Dance, Dance!

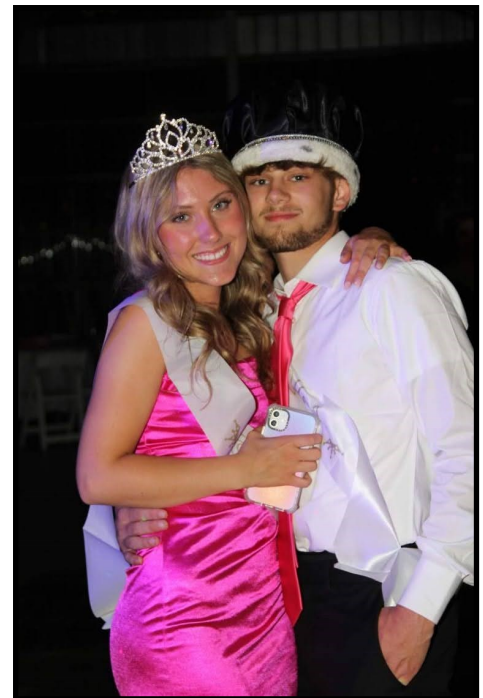

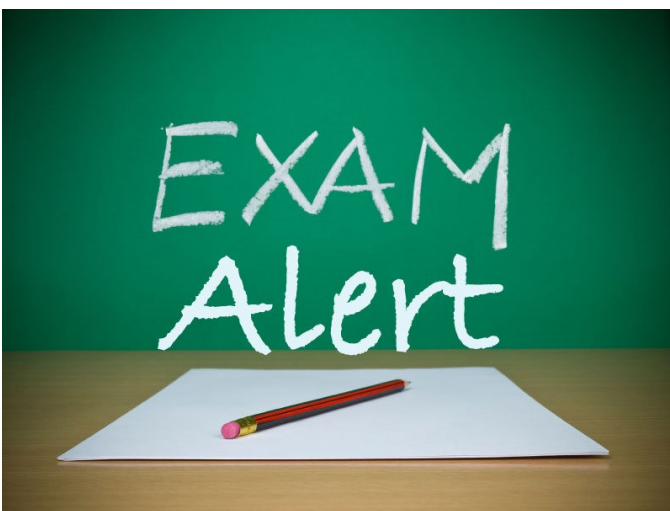
