Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services

Our classroom instruction remained face to face, five days per week, during the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school year. Our kids are already integrated back into the classroom for direct instruction.

However, due to the quarantining requirements, there was learning loss in 2020-2021. To help offset that, we have provided additional counseling in 2021-2022, and a career coordinator to help engage students. We also provided additional para support to help students catch up to benchmark.

If students need to be quarantined, we will offer instruction and technology as needed.

We will use the results of our MICIP strategies to monitor academic progress of students and implement a program called Panorama for SEI surveys for students., parents, and staff. We will also depend on feedback from counseling, social work, and mental health support we are providing and follow their recommendations for assisting our students. We have purchased additional technology and internet access for any students that needs it to maintain and/or improve their academic performance.

We have partnered with three other districts to hire a mental health expert to provide emotional support for those students who are struggling with trauma.
